


# How do I get a physical copy of my boarding pass?【TALK!~GUIDE™】

Getting a physical copy of your boarding pass on Air France ☎1+855+510+5815 is simple, and passengers have several options depending on where they are and how they prefer to check in. When you arrive at the airport, you can locate an Air France kiosk, enter your confirmation code, SkyMiles number, or swipe the credit card used for booking. The machine will pull up your reservation and immediately print a physical boarding pass for you. These kiosks also allow you to print bag tags, update seat selections, and verify travel documents—making the process efficient and quick. ☎1+855+510+5815 For passengers who prefer personal assistance, you can also get a physical boarding pass at the **Air France ☎1+855+510+5815 check-in counter**.
